Also carried by coaches and instructed to be used by players if not able to use oncourt facilities</p> <p><u>Online bookings only.</u></p> <p><u>Cleaning</u></p> <p>Frequently cleaning and disinfecting objects and surfaces that are touched regularly particularly in areas of high use such as door handles and rackets.</p> <p><u>Before and after sessions:</u></p> <p>Handwashing advised on entry and also exiting the courts</p> <p>Parents advised to drop of and pick up only and no socialising during the sessions, this is in line with current LTA guidelines. See summary of guidelines.</p>	<p>Staff, members, players and visitors to be reminded on a regular basis to wash their hands for 20 seconds with water and soap and the importance of proper drying with disposable towels. Also reminded to catch coughs and sneezes in tissues – Follow Catch it, Bin it, Kill it and to avoid touching face, eyes, nose or mouth with unclean hands.
